

FAQS FOR TRIBUTE PROGRAMME:



Q1. What is the Tribute programme?

TP participants will be typically involved with ministries of the local parish including overseas missions, and be working alongside the full time ministry staff. TP participants could also be attached to serve in various areas of Anglican ministries, such as schools, educational, social services and community hospitals both locally and overseas. Attachments to any of such areas will be made by the pastor concerned, in consultation with the Director of Missions.

Q2. Who can participate in the Tribute programme?

The Tribute program is an opportunity for Anglicans to offer themselves for a one year commitment to serve God in a full time capacity. This is a voluntary act of worship and it can be expressed through a number of ways:

- a. Giving the first year of one's working life to serve God in a full time capacity, before entering the job market, or
- b. Giving one year to serve God in a full time capacity during a job transition and resuming normal employment in the future, or
- c. Retiring, and be "re-tyred" to serve God by offering one year to work in a full time capacity.

The Tribute Program is open to all members of the Anglican parishes in Singapore.

Q3. What training, if any, will be provided for TP participants?

There will be centralised Orientation and Training for the Tribute participants in July every year. The program teaches team bonding and the Anglican ethos amongst participants. It will provide opportunities for discipleship, team work and missions within the life of the Diocese.

Although July will be the official start point for the Tribute programme, it is possible for participants to join in the program at any point of the year. In this case, the participants will need to attend as much of the Orientation and Training program as possible, once they are enrolled into this program.

Q4. Is there any financial consideration?

Each Tribute participant would be given a small living allowance by the parish concerned. At the Diocesan level, financial support will be considered on a case to case basis, to help parishes that are financially not able to support their young people in this program.
